Models ES2.5 (2.7 gal) and ES4 (4 gal) mount under a cabinet or sink with included bracket – simply hook up to the water supply and plug into 120 volt electrical connection. Model ES8 (7.1 gal) has built-in junction box for hard-wiring to comply with the electric code.
