Bosch Introduces Two New Greenstar Condensing Boiler Models and New Venting Options for All Models

- New Models: Greenstar Combi 131 & Greenstar 79
- Wall-Mounted for Space Savings and Fast Service/Maintenance
- Greenstar Product Line Provides 95% AFUE
- Now has 5 Space Heating Boilers and 3 Combi Models
- New Concentric Up and Out Venting and Polypropylene Twin Pipe

AHR Expo, New York City – Bosch Thermotechnology has introduced two new models of its Greenstar gas condensing boiler line. All models are designed for residential applications and have an AFUE rating of 95%. The new Greenstar Combi 131 with an 131 MBH input provides space heating and hot water at up to 3.2 GPM (ΔT at 72° F) and the Greenstar 79 with a 79 MBH input is for space heating only.

New venting options from Bosch for the Greenstar line include concentric up and out venting and polypropylene twin pipe for installation flexibility. The up and out venting option kit consists of an appliance adaptor, a 90° elbow and a telescopic termination that accommodates varying wall thicknesses.

Greenstar wall-mounted boilers feature ultra-efficient condensing technology that includes a hydronic manifold and three-speed integral pump, allowing faster installation.

With the addition of these two models Bosch Thermotechnology's Greenstar boiler family consists of five space heating boilers with inputs of 57, 79, 100, 131 and 151 MBH. The three combi units have inputs of 100, 131 and 155 MBH for residential applications. All Greenstar products come with a limited lifetime heat exchanger warranty and a limited 5-year parts and labor warranty (see www.boschheatingandcooling.com for complete warranty details.
