Greentherm’s patented heat exchanger captures latent heat from the flue gases to yield thermal efficiencies of up to 98% with an Energy Factor of 0.95.

Greentherm models are now equipped with an automated and fully modulating active bypass for unsurpassed temperature stability. An inlet water filter featuring easy external access is now standard on all models. Greentherm condensing models feature a durable heat exchanger design with copper piping providing the complete water path.

Bosch Greentherm condensing tankless water heaters offer maximum efficiency even at low flow rates. These wall-mounted units offer multiple venting options including fast and simple concentric polypropylene up and out for single units and two to four unit single pipe cascades vented together through a sidewall or roof with the new Polypropylene Common Venting System from Bosch.

Greentherm models are available in both NG and LP versions.

Bosch provides a 15-year limited warranty on the Greentherm’s heat exchanger; other parts carry a 5-year limited warranty and a 1-year warranty on labor.
